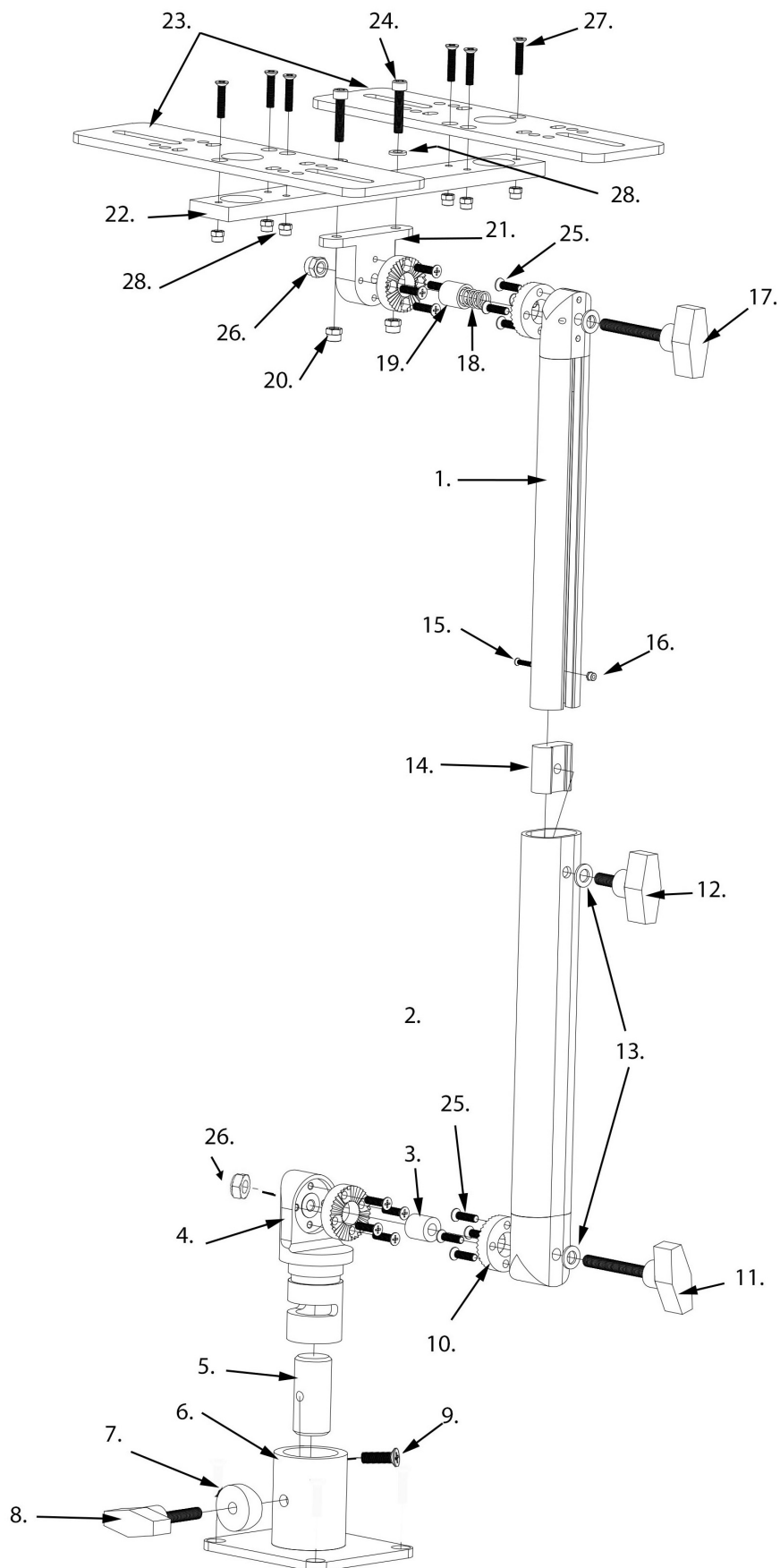


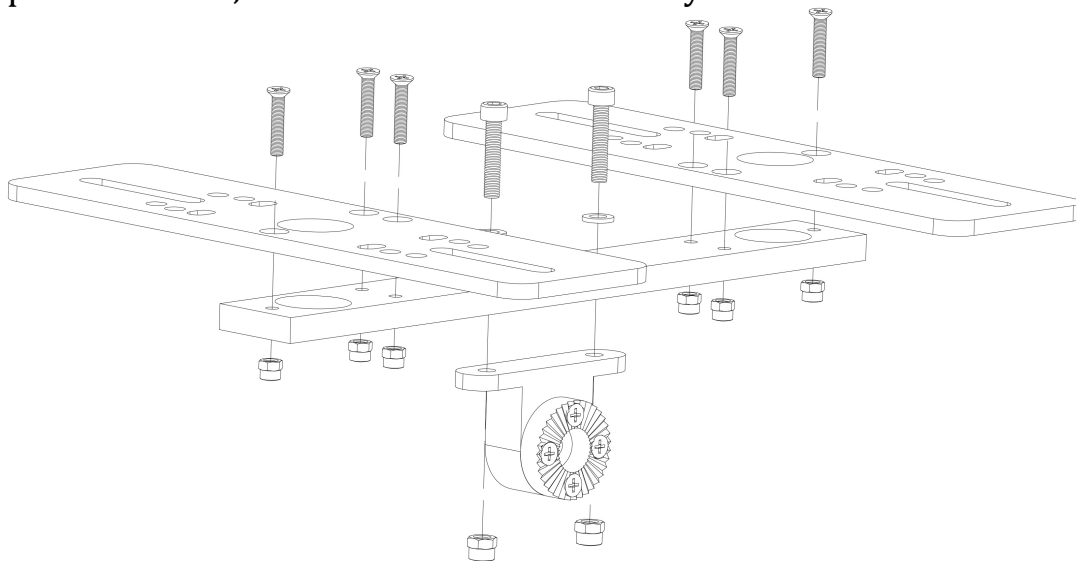

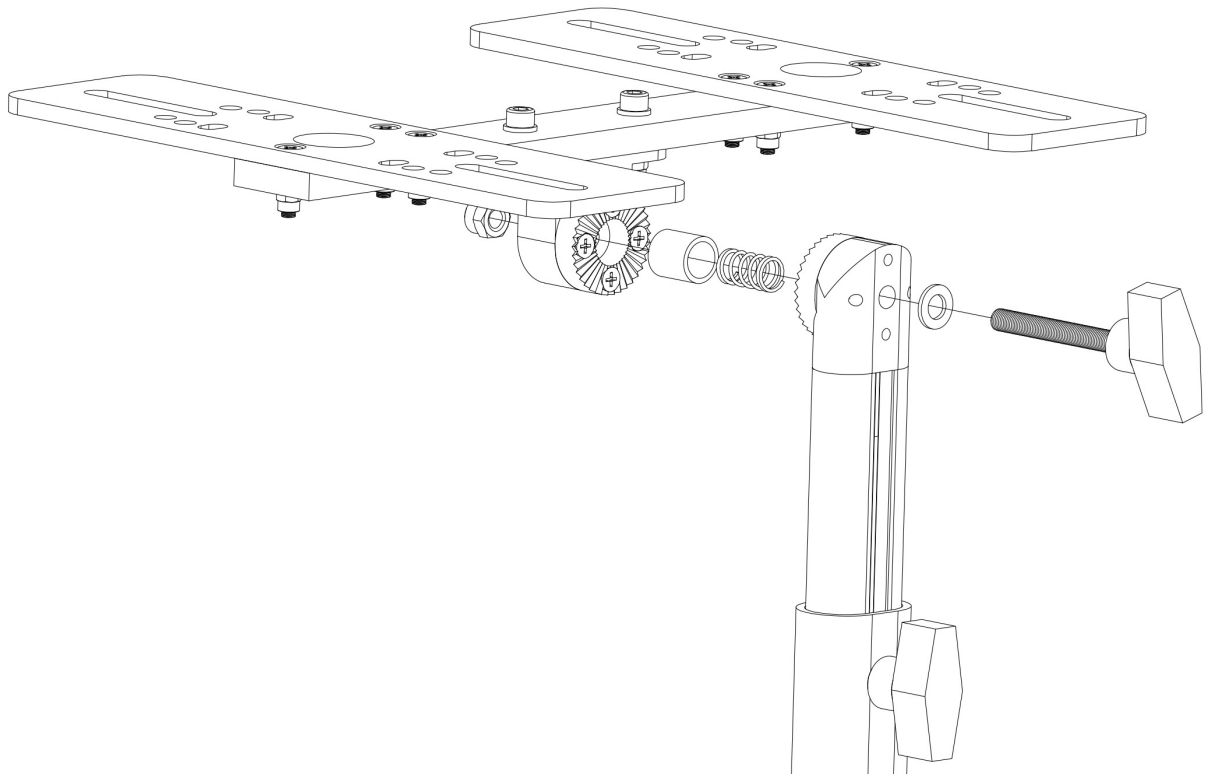
ASSEMBLY

Step 1: Assemble the mounting plates to the Mounting Bridge using six 10/24 x 1" bolts and Ny-loc nuts. Also assemble the mounting Bridge to the Pitch Block using two 1/4" x 1-1/4" cap head screws, two flat washers and two Ny-Loc nuts as seen in Image 1.



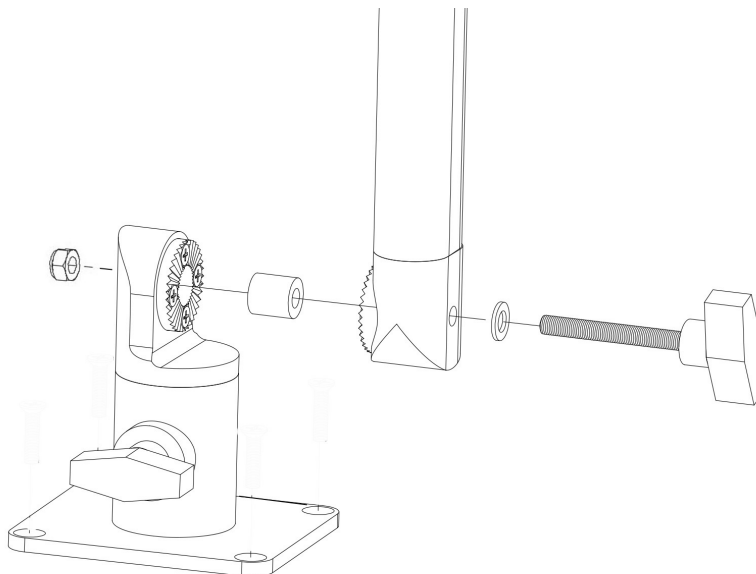

STEP 2: Assemble the mount assembly to the top of the upright as seen in Image 2. NOTE: The lock nut should be installed on the end of the knob as a safety to prevent it from coming lose, it should not be tight.

STEP 3: Assemble the bottom of the upright assembly to the Rotational mount as seen in Image 3. place Nylock nut on the end of the knob as a safety, it should not be tight.

NOTE: Check all knobs and hardware frequently to make sure they are tight.
